Dear Friend,

We have wonderful news to share with you!

The James Family Foundation has committed to donating the amount of funding to purchase 1,023 acres of our leased land!! The wild horses finally have a home that is truly theirs!!!

The parcels that will be purchased include our overnight camp and, combined with land use that is currently donated, the resident wild herds will have 1,840 acres to roam freely on. Because we'll be retaining almost 40% of the leased acreage, we can continue our weekend trail rides, which are essential to both on-going support and public awareness.

We are thrilled – all the efforts of so many volunteers – writing articles, e-mails, calling media folks, sharing the story of our need – helped us get the word out.

We are so thankful for all the effort that allowed this family foundation to learn about the Wild Horse Sanctuary. A small San Francisco based entity; the James Family Foundation is dedicated to assisting non-profit organizations committed to conservation, education, the arts and medical research. We couldn't be happier of their involvement.

We remain optimistic that yet more of the formerly leased lands can be purchased a section at a time so that the wild horses can keep the entire home of 5,000 acres that they have enjoyed for the past 20 years. Not only would the larger acreage provide an enhanced natural life but also more native grazing keeps hay costs down.

We'll continue to strive toward the goal of land purchase as long as the land is available so that we will never have to turn away any horse that has nowhere else to go.

Currently, the resident herds are being held on a 30-acre field while we await the formalizing of the sale and transfer of title. Once accomplished, we must fence the newly purchased land from the
